
RADIOCARBON DEATH DATES — This graph portrays Whitelow's 25,000 corrected carbon 14 datings. The graph peaks in section B, at the time when there occurred the huge destruction at the time of the Flood. Section A would represent the gradual increase in dateable remains as life slowly multiplied again after the Flood. Whitelow arrived at a 7,000-year B.P. [before present] Creation date by comparing radiocarbon production and disintegration, and is based on the assumption that there was no change in the vapor canopy or amount of available carbon prior to the Flood. Adjusting for changes in those two factors could easily bring the date of Creation down to c. 6,000 years B.P.
